Garden veggie sticks – arranged in little terracotta look paper cups

Melon flowers – using a cookie cutter to make flower shapes on skewers



Rainbow veggie shields – round crackers arranged like a shield.

Superhero energy bites – simple oat and honey balls "power pellets"



Honeycomb toast fingers – drizzled lightly with honey, in hexagon shapes.

Ladybird yoghurt cups – with berries or choc chips as spots.



Bowling ball fruit skewers – round fruit on skewers.

Bowling lane veggie platter – with a cherry tomato "ball" rolling toward cheese cube "pins".



Team colour yoghurt parfaits – layered yoghurt and fruit.

Energy bites – simple oat and honey no-bake balls.

Toast fingers – simple toast strips, easy to relate to "building beams"

Paddle pop stick pretzels – long pretzel rods laid out like building materials, served with a dip

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Enrolment & Bookings

- Children must have a completed enrolment form before Vacation Care bookings can be accepted (see QR code below).
- Once your enrolment has been processed, all bookings, cancellations, and attendance updates must be submitted through OWNA (see QR code).
- A booking is not confirmed until you receive confirmation from Mustard Seed Christian Childcare.
- Bookings made within 7 days of the session date will incur a late booking fee of \$6.00 per child, per day.
- Bookings close 48 hours prior to the commencement of each session.
- Any booking requests received after this time must be arranged directly with the service and are subject to availability.
- Once a session reaches capacity, a waiting list will apply.

Cancellations & Absences

- Cancellations must be submitted at least 14 days prior to the booked session to avoid out-of-pocket charges.
- Cancellations made within 14 days of the booked session will be charged in full.
- Fees will still apply if a child is absent due to illness or any other reason.

Arrival & Collection

- Children must be signed in and out each day by a parent or a person listed as an authorised nominee on the enrolment record.
- Children may only be collected by a parent or persons listed as authorised nominees on the enrolment record.
- Families are responsible for ensuring all contact, medical, and emergency information remains current.

Food & Nutrition

- Morning and afternoon tea will be provided by the service each day.
- Children must bring a nutritious lunch and any additional snacks required throughout the day.
- Children must bring a refillable water bottle each day.
- Mustard Seed Christian Childcare is a nut aware service. Families are asked not to pack nuts or foods containing nuts.

Clothing & Personal Belongings

- Children must wear enclosed shoes and clothing suitable for active play and weather conditions.
- Thongs, slides, and singlet tops are not permitted.
- Children must bring a hat each day for outdoor activities.
- All personal belongings, including lunch boxes, drink bottles, and clothing, should be clearly labelled.
- Mustard Seed Christian Childcare accepts no responsibility for lost, damaged, or stolen items.

Personal Electronic Devices

- Personal electronic devices MUST NOT be brought to Vacation Care.
- Children WILL NOT be permitted to use personal electronic devices whilst attending the service.

Program Changes

- Mustard Seed Christian Childcare reserves the right to make changes to the Vacation Care program where required due to circumstances beyond our control.
- This may include changes to excursions, incursions, venues, scheduled activities, or advertised experiences.
- Families will be notified of significant changes where possible.
- Where appropriate, an alternative activity of equal or similar value will be provided.
