Sydney Organs member Isabel Li is not only an accomplished organist and pianist, she is also a scholar of orchestral percussion.

In July, by invitation, Isabel will attend Juilliard's Summer Music Percussion program which is an intensive three-week conservatory experience at Lincoln Center in New York City. It prepares advanced high school percussionists (typically ages 14-18) for college auditions and careers in music through master classes, orchestral training, and world music exploration. Instruction and master classes are led by prominent musicians from groups like the New York Philharmonic and Metropolitan Opera Orchestra.
